PLEASE CONFIRM THAT YOUR BOAT HAS ON BOARD:

- A BAILER OF SUITABLE SIZE
- BUOYANCY AIDS  
IT IS A REQUIREMENT THAT ALL BOATS COMPETING IN THE RACE CARRY ADEQUATE BUOYANCY AIDS FOR EACH PERSON ABOARD AND ANY PERSONS UNDER 16 YEARS OF AGE TAKING PART IN THE RACE MUST WEAR A BUOYANCY AID AT ALL TIMES. (See SGNs)
- STRONG POINT FOR TOWING AND A STRONG TOW LINE. ANY TOWING WILL BE UNDERTAKEN ONLY AT THE BOAT OWNER'S RISK.
- A FLAG NO SMALLER THAN 36" X 24" (90 x 60cms)

YOU ACKNOWLEDGE THAT YOUR COX / PASSENGER MUST CLEARLY HOLD UP YOUR START NUMBER TO THE RACE MARSHALLS WHEN PASSING THE BARGE AT THE START AND TIMING TENT AT THE FINISH LINE. NOT DOING SO WILL RESULT IN YOUR RACE NOT BEING TIMED.

YOU WILL ADHERE TO THE RACE INSTRUCTIONS & RULES INCLUDING;

- FOLLOW THE INSTRUCTIONS OF RACE MARSHALLS AND SAFETY BOAT CREWS AT ALL TIMES.
- OVERTAKING BOATS HAVE THE RESPONSIBILITY TO KEEP CLEAR OF OTHER CRAFT. IF BEING OVERTAKEN YOU MUST NOT MOVE TO IMPEDE THE OVERTAKING BOAT.
- OVERTAKING UNDER BRIDGES IS NOT ALLOWED.
- YOU HAVE READ AND ACCEPT THE INSTRUCTIONS ABOUT WHICH BRIDGE ARCHES YOU CAN USE.
- AT RICHMOND LOCK & WEIR (RL & W) YOU SHOULD NOT TRY TO GO THROUGH THE ARCH UNTIL ALL SLUICES ARE FULLY RAISED AS DEBRIS CAN DROP OUT AS THEY ARE BEING RAISED.
- ACCEPT THAT SCRUTINEERS MAY CHECK YOUR BOAT AND SAFETY EQUIPMENT AND NON-COMPLIANCE WITH THESE SAFETY RULES MAY RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION FROM THE RACE.
